This week we raise our gaze up from the covenant of mercy signature to Christ's feet.

How can Christ's feet and stance speak of His Mercy? Notice how Christ's left foot is slightly ahead of his right one...as if he were walking?

"God's mercy is always in motion, always seeking us, always moving toward us, wanting to be close to us..."

As Pope John Paul II stated: "In Jesus Christ, God not only speaks to man but also seeks him out...God goes in search of man, created in his own image and likeness,...because he loves him eternally in the Word,...God seeks man out, moved by his fatherly heart."
