Thanksgiving Food Drive 2015- November 22, 2015

Each month our PSR students prepare 120 sandwiches that are taken to Karen House (a shelter in north St. Louis for homeless women and their children) to help feed their clients and also some of the homeless men who live in the area.

For Thanksgiving, our Annunziata St. Vincent de Paul conference provides 12 turkeys which, along with the other makings for a feast provided by PSR classes, will be distributed by The Catholic Workers at Karen House. They use two turkeys to feed the clients in the house and the rest of the food will be given to needy families in the neighborhood. Pairs of families join together to prepare their Thanksgiving feast. In this way we will feed 20 families and help build community around Karen House.

This year, we are asking the children to bring the following food items to class on Sunday, Nov 22nd. There will be boxes in the front entrance for them to drop their donations off as they came in to class.

Pre-K, K, and 1 st grade:	rolls and stuffing mix
2 nd grade:	cranberry sauce
3 rd grade:	pumpkin pie filling
4 th grade:	pie crusts
5 th grade:	sweet potatoes or yams
6 th grade:	cool whip
7 th grade:	potatoes
8 th grade:	canned green beans, mushroom soup, dried French onions (canned)
