

AN INVITATION TO EACH OF US



PROGRESS REPORT UPDATE

With the completion of the tuck pointing, most of the materials for the new flat roofs of our Church have been delivered to the staging area behind the Priest's garage, in preparation for the work to begin. As you can see from this aerial photo, the slate on the roof is in good condition; however, the flat roofs surrounding it need to be replaced. The 10 flat roofs will be torn off down to the lightweight concrete deck on the original Church and down to the steel deck on the addition. New roofs, including sheet metal work, will then be installed. The roofing work cost is \$93,591.00 and the sheet metal is \$34,632.








THE JEWELER'S SHOP: A MODERN MYSTERY BY POPE JOHN PAUL II



Making a Difference on Journeys that Get Us There

Both of my daughters have danced since they were in pre-school. Luckily, my son's karate studio was a stone's throw from the Dance Center. Before the older two could drive, there were nights when I'd travel back and forth to Kirkwood more than four times! Sound familiar? My son is in college now, and my older daughter has been driving for a year. I have to admit, I miss the time I spent with the kids in the car. There were gifts in those daunting journeys.



Our family uses an app called Life 360 for notification when the kids arrive at their destinations. Every time they leave home, I pray the Hail Mary and ask our Blessed Mother to watch over them on their journeys. When I hear the little chime on my phone that lets me know they've arrived, I say another Hail Mary, thanking our Mother for her protection. I get the alert again when they are on their way home and my prayers are offered up once more. My heart isn't truly at rest until I see those headlights shining on the driveway, and they are home.

My office is in the lower level of the rectory. It is spacious with calming, blue-gray walls. I've decorated it nicely with statues of saints, Catholic art, plaques, artwork from my children, photos, a dry erase board with messages from loved ones, etc. Each morning as I circle the office turning on lamps, I pause at each decoration and offer a small prayer that relates to it. These decorations serve as reminders prayers like I should. I do know that the faster we move, the more we need God to get us to our destination. Let's challenge ourselves this week: when we pass by our crucifix, family Bible, saint statues, rosary, etc., let's offer a quick prayer, even if we have to keep moving as we do so. The Father understands that sometimes our journey demands speed, but when we put him in the driver's seat, we'll get to where we really need to go.


