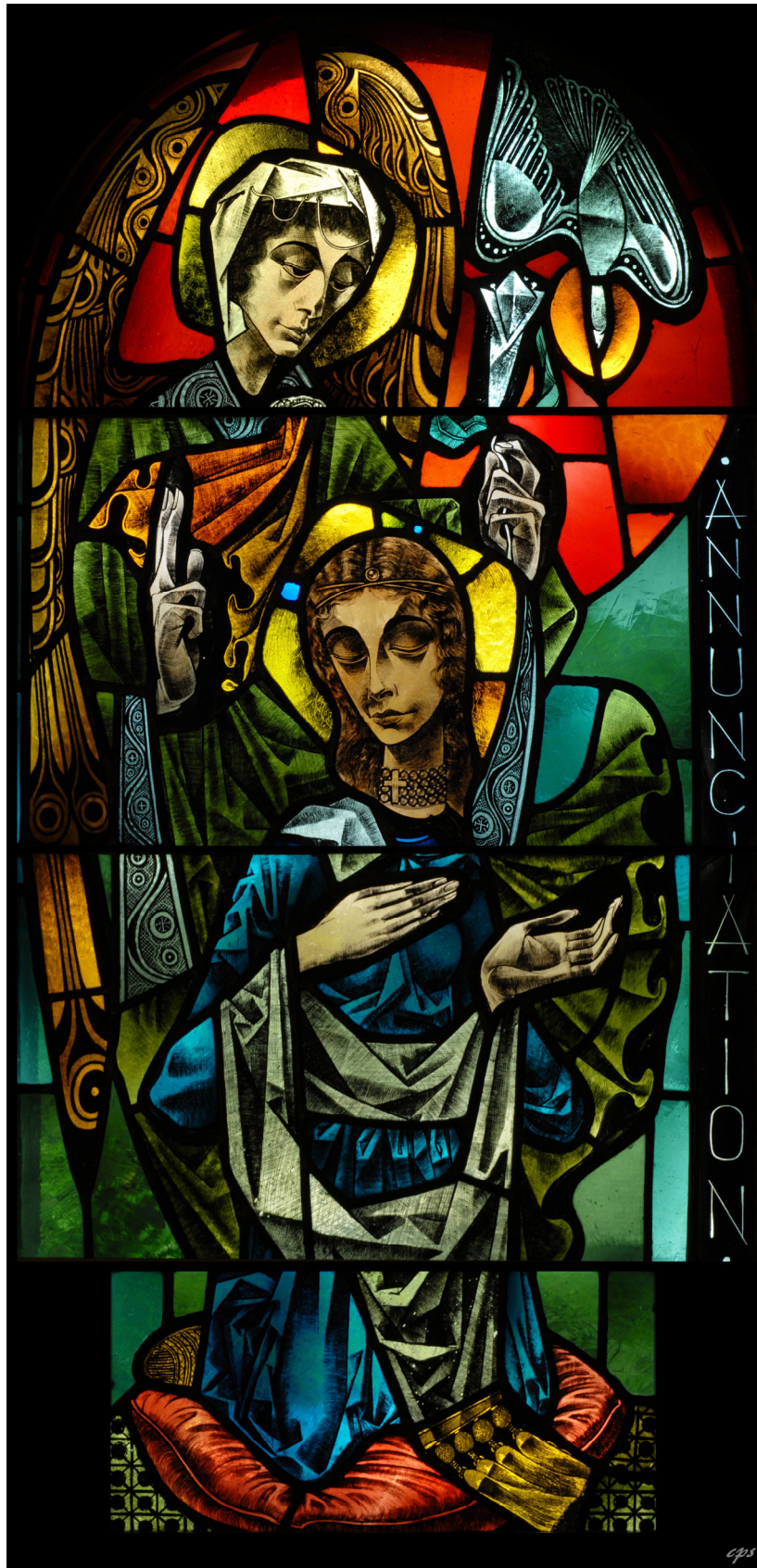

THE GIFT OF A BOOK

Over the course of the last several years, I have wanted to offer opportunities for us to read things that will help deepen our understanding of the precious treasure of our Catholic Faith, help us grow in intimacy with God, and share our Faith with our families, friends, and others in our lives. Certainly books such as Rediscover Catholicism, The Four Signs of a Dynamic Catholic, The Joy of Love, Rediscover Jesus, and Resisting Happiness have helped us do that.



The Book offered today after Mass, Bishop Robert Barron's Letter to a Suffering Church, is not inviting Catholics to turn a blind eye, or to simply carry on the status quo. 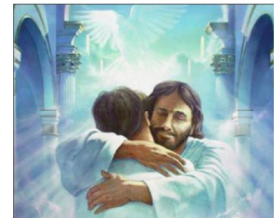

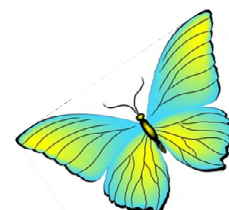
