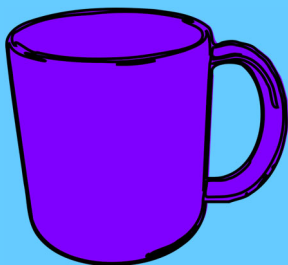

## FROM OUR PASTOR .....

**EXCITING YEAR**

Today, the Parish Families of the Parish School of Religion have the opportunity to meet and greet their Teachers for the coming year. These Teachers, who volunteer their time and talent, are powerful reminders that we all have a role in bringing people to Christ. While parents have the privilege and primary responsibility of teaching the Catholic Faith to their child/children, the whole of our parish are there to help them.

IF YOU KNOW OF ANY CHILD, FROM PRE-SCHOOL THRU THE EIGHTH GRADE who is not receiving Formation in their Catholic Faith, please invite their parents to call our PRINCIPAL, LAURA GYAWALI, (993-4422) to register them. Every child in Annunziata Parish has a God given right to Christ's Church's teaching and to be prepared for the Sacraments.

This past week we celebrated the Feast of St. Monica and her son, St. Augustine. Augustine left the Church when he was a young man and ended up, after his conversion, as one of God's greatest Saints and a leader in Christ's Church. "It's a good time to reflect on how he got there and to ask ourselves: What role we are called to play for the many Augustines who populate our lives?"

St. Monica, Augustine's mother, played a role in bringing him back to his Catholic Faith: her prayers were crucial to his conversion. St. Ambrose, his bishop, also had a role: his example and preaching were pivotal.

"The team of Sts. Monica and Ambrose calls to mind other great teams in which people played complementary roles in bringing people to Christ – sometimes during times of great upheaval in the Church .... The example of these "CONVERSION TEAMS" raises two questions for us: What's our Team? What is our role on that Team?"

"The 'TEAM' questions are important because none of us is called to salvation alone. On the one hand, this is simply a fact: when we are Baptized we become members of the Body of Christ, not lone rangers. On the other hand, it is also an imperative. Jesus will ask us not only, 'How did you do?' Jesus will ask us, 'Who are you bringing with you?' None of us can do it all."

St. Paul said that the Church is a Body: it has different organs, and each plays a different and an important role. We need to ask these questions about our lives:

What's my Team? – First and foremost this is my family, my friends, my coworkers.

We can't ignore the rest of the world, but the first and deepest place we're called to make a difference is in our home team.

What is my role? – We all have different roles to play in bringing people to conversion. The effectiveness of the Body of Christ in reaching them requires that we play our roles well, and help others to play theirs. As we have seen recently, when any part of the Body fails in its responsibilities, the rest of the Body of Christ pays the price.

There are many pre-conversion St. Augustines in the world today. Instead of judging them or gossiping about them, let's pray and think deeply about how we can reach them with the Good News of Jesus!
