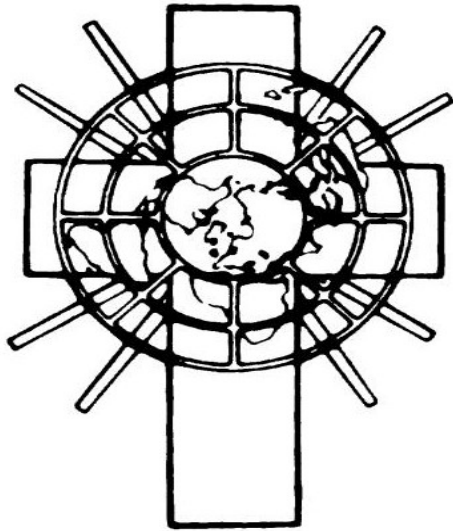

It is a time of prayer and reflection that will bring you closer to Our Lady's Immaculate Heart and to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

### **Fiat Women's Group**

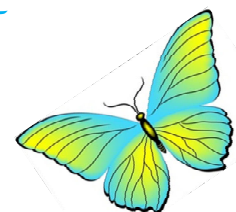
