INFLUENZA & THE MASS

As I announced last weekend at all our Masses, until the end of Lent, we are suspending the distribution of Holy Communion via the chalice. In addition, when the exchange of peace is offered, it is recommended that we do not shake hands, but turn to the person next to us and say, "Peace be with you." Holy Communion is encouraged to be received in the hand.

When discussing the coronavirus, we should only emphasize the facts that we know to be true, which are the following: Season flu is currently making a bigger impact on communities. There have been 10,000 deaths from the flu in the U.S. thus far. The potential global public health threat posed by this virus is high, however, right now, the immediate risk to most Americans is low.

If you have a respiratory infection, the flu, a fever or a serious cold, you are encouraged to stay home and be reassured that you are not bound to participate in weekend Sunday Mass.

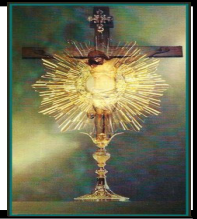
Diaper Drive

From the weekend of March 21-22 through Palm Sunday, April 5, the Permanent Deacons in the Archdiocese of St. Louis, in conjunction with the Respect Life office, will be collecting diapers for newborns, infants and toddlers—as well as adult incontinence products—as part of the annual diocesan-wide Pro-Life service project. Last year this effort yielded over 325,000 diapers. These are provided to local charities that aid individuals and families in an initiative that fights poverty and restores dignity.
