
COME, HOLY SPIRIT!

PENTECOST is the ideal time to be realistic about what the Holy Spirit can accomplish in everyone of us who is open to the Grace that is offered——

- 1) To deepen, through prayer and the sacraments, my relationship with the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- 2) To spread the Good News of salvation to those around me.
- 3) To sanctify and perfect the work I perform to support my Family and Home Life.
- 4) To nurture my spouse's Faith.
- 5) To pass on the precious gift of the Catholic Faith to our children through my example of living my Catholic Faith.
- 6) To build up the community of believers by generously living out the ideal of sacrificial love and to seek forgiveness for the many times I fail to imitate Jesus in conforming my will to the will of Our Heavenly Father.

COME, HOLY SPIRIT!

PENTECOST offers the opportunity to purify and renew the Church that Christ founded and placed in our hands. In a memorable chapter of *The Everlasting Man* called "The Five Deaths of the Faith" G.K. Chesterton recounts a few of the many historical episodes in which the Church was "to all appearances been hollowed out from within by doubt and indifference." Yet Christ's Church rose again with new vigor, for "in every such case, the sons and daughters were fanatical for the faith where the fathers and mothers had been slack about it." God continues to raise up saints, in altogether unlikely places, and Christ's Church not only survives, but is renewed. Have you seriously considered whether you are one of those saints?



As a final instruction, Jesus said, “I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another” (cf. John 13:34-35). In other words, when we love others – those we know and those we may never meet – we bear witness to our faith.


