### ST. LOUIS COUNTY'S NEW COVID-19 GUIDELINES

Beginning this weekend (August 1-2), St. Louis County has mandated that gatherings are limited to no more than 50 people. This new fifty (50) person rule does NOT apply to parish capacity for Holy Mass. However, the 25-percent capacity rule does apply. Practically this means that **Annunziata Church will remain at 80 persons**, the 25% we have presently, allowing for six feet distancing. Masks continue to be mandatory, except to receive Holy Communion. Thank You for your patience and understanding!

### LESSONS FOR LIFE

- ◆ We would spend more time with our families and friends, and be more keenly aware of our massive good fortune to have them, especially the older ones.
- ◆ We would spend less time with our faces in our phones, and more time facing each other.
- ◆ We would love our neighbors. Yes, even that one.
- ◆ We would work together to make those who are alone feel less so.
- ◆ We would plan better for tomorrow and next year.
- ◆ We would make wills, and health care proxies.
- ◆ We would leave less unsaid.
- ◆ We would be more grateful for all we have, and more outraged at what others do not.
- ◆ Trusting in God, we would pray more and worry less.
