FROM OUR PASTOR.....

I WELCOME Father Paul Hoelsing as the Preacher for this year's Parish Lenten Mission. When Father Hoelsing accepted the invitation last year, I was truly excited for our Parish. He has preached at many special events around the Archdiocese besides his primary responsibility as Vice-Rector for Formation at our Kenrick-Glennon Seminary.



Father Paul is a rural native of the Omaha Archdiocese. He attended St. John Vianney Seminary in St. Paul, MN and continued formation for the Priesthood at the North American College in Rome. Ordained in 2002, Fr. Hoelsing completed the licentiate in dogmatic theology at the Gregorian University in Rome, then served five years as an associate pastor and high school chaplain in urban and rural areas. He has served as the Vocation Director of his home diocese, served as a faculty member for the Institute for Priestly Formation at Creighton University, and has been on loan to our Seminary for the last ten years.

Father Hoelsing will preach all the weekend Sunday Masses on March 28 and 29. On Monday, March 30th, Father will celebrate Mass and preach our Mission Mass at 7:00 p.m. Following Mass the Priests will offer the Sacrament of the Anointing. (A good time to remember what Pope St. Paul VI taught—this Sacrament is for those who are having surgery, or recovering from it, the elderly, those who are dealing with depression, or fighting addictions, or experiencing chronic pain.)

Tuesday, March 31st, Father Hoelsing will not be with us. We are suggesting some time at home to pray together as a Family, read and discuss a Bible story, and share our Catholic Faith.

Wednesday, April 1st, Father will offer the closing Mass of our Lenten Mission at 7:00 p.m. Following Mass we will have four priests to offer the Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation/Confession) in preparation for Easter.

LENTEN BENEDICTION

This Wednesday, March 18, our guest celebrant for Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament is Father Michael Rennier, the Pastor of Epiphany of Our Lord Parish. Benediction begins at 6:30 p.m. and concludes promptly at 7:15 p.m.

Interestingly, in 1980, Pope St. John Paul II created something called the Pastoral Provision to ordain former Anglican priests, and some of those priests were married, like Father Michael Rennier.

PASTORAL PROTECTIONS AT MASS DURING THE CORONAVIRUS

A cause you can really get behind.

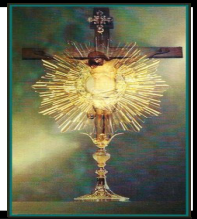

Please prayerfully consider praying a holy hour beginning this lent.

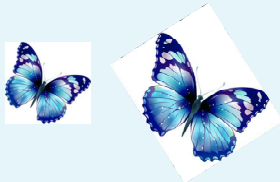
