Amen.

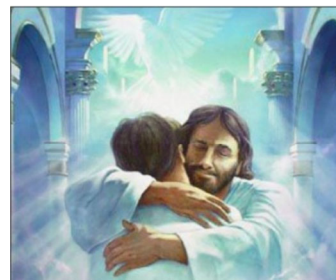

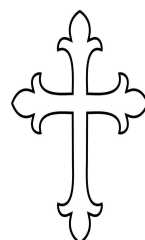

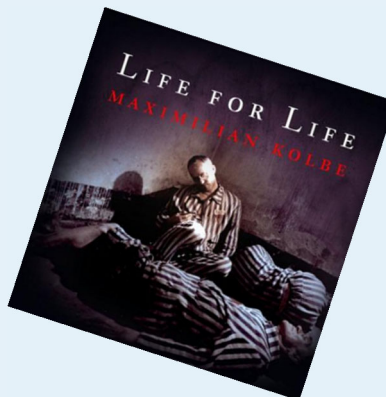
