## **FROM OUR PASTOR.....**

### **HOW TO PRAY DURING THIS TIME OF UNREST**



Here in St. Louis there are two families who attend the same Baptist Church. The first family is Caucasian. They asked their fellow Church members, who are African American, for guidance on what to pray for in this time of hurt and anger. This is the response from the African American Family, whose sixteen year old daughter was a big contributor:

1. **Pray to see the lost as God sees the lost.**
2. **Pray for your empathy to increase in situations that you do not understand.**
3. **Ask God to help love your neighbors in their time of hardship.**
4. **Ask God what your role is in this situation.**
5. **Ask God to forgive those who do not glorify God with their actions, thoughts and speech.**
6. **Pray for God's Spirit to come in and ease the hearts of the angry.**
7. **Ask God to place love above politics.**
8. **Ask God to help you live biblically in everything.**
9. **Give God what troubles your heart during this time.**
10. **Pray that God is ultimately glorified through it all.**
11. **Pray for wisdom in the hearts of our political leaders, police forces, and citizens.**
12. **Pray that we make a better world for the future generations.**
13. **Pray for the salvation of the police officer Derek Chauvin, who was charged with murder.**
14. **Pray for Derek Chauvin's family.**
15. **Pray for George Floyd's family.**
16. **Pray for patience in the hearts of all people.**
17. **Pray for protestors to continue protesting peacefully without riots.**
18. **Pray that God will grant each of us wisdom, knowledge, courage, and discernment to be open to the change we want to see.**

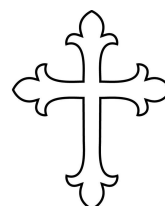
