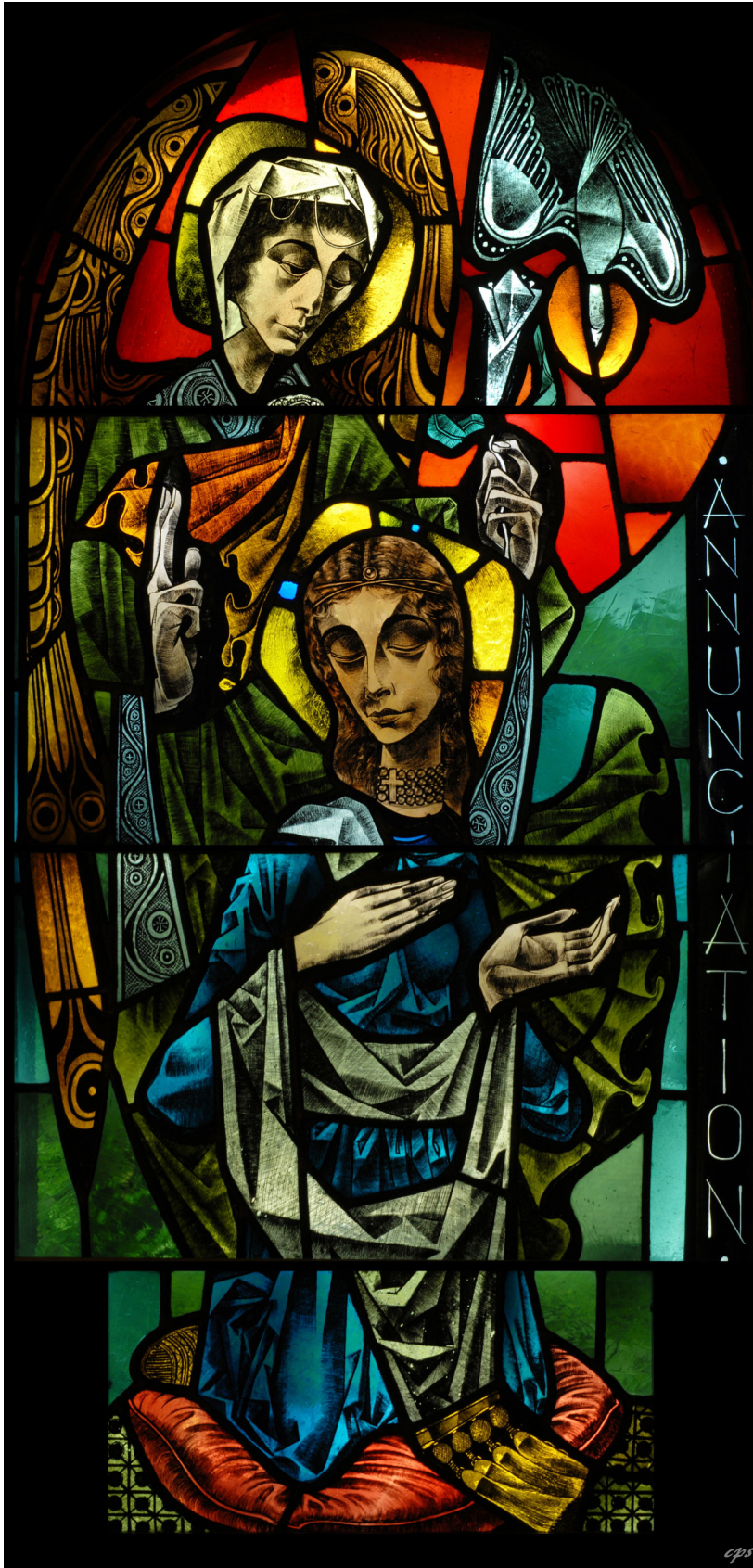

STATUS ANIMARUM

The Latin “Status Animarum” translates “State of the Souls.” It is the annual parish report that compiles general information and statistics for the the Archbishop and those who assist Him in the administration of the Archdiocese of St. Louis.

This year marks the 90th Anniversary of the Church of the Annunziata’s founding by some 25 families under the leadership of Father Charleville Benoist Faris. No amount of statistics can begin to capture our heartfelt gratitude to God for the Incredible Graces and Blessings given to Annunziata over the years. In the last fiscal year, July 2018—June 2019, we were blessed to have 24 new households join our Parish, for a total of 647 households, made up of 1,855 Catholics.

In the last twelve months, it is wonderful to report that we had 39 Baptisms, 1 Profession of Faith at the Easter Vigil, 23 First Confessions, 23 First Holy Communions, 19 Confirmations, and 8 Marriages. The Sacrament of the Anointing was offered and received many times each week throughout the year. We also commended eighteen parishioners into the arms of Jesus, Our Savior. Next week, I will continue the highlights of our Status Animarum, reflecting on our Parish School of Religion, our Annunziata Special School, completed projects and current/upcoming projects. Please continue to pray for our Parish and our Archdiocese.
