

WHAT'S YOUR STORY?

St. Bernard of Clairvaux described three comings of Christ at Advent: the historical birth of Jesus in Bethlehem, the coming of Jesus into our lives each day, and Christ's final coming in glory at the end of time. Naturally, most of our focus is on the Nativity, the birth of Jesus, the baby in the manger. This is no surprise, as it is the beginning of the greatest story ever told.

By his life, death and resurrection, Jesus gave us fullness in life. He instituted the Eucharist and taught us to seek the grace of God's mercy so that we might remain close to the Father for all eternity. But the story doesn't end there. At Mass, our priest, in the person of Christ, commands us to go forth to love and serve the Lord and each other. Essentially, God is saying, "My faithful children, the story of my salvation lives on in you."

Advent is a time for us to reflect and ask ourselves, "How does my part in God's story of salvation read? Do my daily words and actions reflect the light of Jesus or propagate negativity? Am I using the gifts God gave me to serve him, or am I self-promoting? Do I keep close to the Father, or am I preoccupied with earthly things?"

We know that God's story on earth will end with the second coming of Jesus to judge the living and the dead, but we don't know when that might be. Jesus warns us to always be prepared for that day. Advent is our chance to make the edits necessary to ensure that our ending is a happy one.
