For all parishioners who are new to the Parish, this year marks the Ninetieth Anniversary for Your Parish! In 1929, Father Charleville Faris and twenty-five families entered into the Life of Jesus in forming a new parish named Annunziata. They discovered that Jesus is the narrow door leading to limitless love, sacrificial generosity, and heartfelt forgiveness. These families worked as a team as they looked out for the good of each other and for those who were in need.

Property on which a spacious 1907 home was located at Clayton and Cella Roads was donated by the Faris Family. The onset of the Depression eliminated any early hopes for a Church to be built. Fr. Faris converted the first floor library into a Chapel, which served the parishioners of Annunziata for the next twenty-four years.

Parishes exist to help us be transformed through God's Grace to be the "best version of Jesus that we can become." It is also true that parishioners, by their active participation in the life and ministry of our parish, can help transform their parish. It is our heartfelt hope that our efforts together can continue to make Annunziata a great Family where people feel welcome and can encounter the person of Jesus.

It is not in spectacular events or monumental places that our Parish changes our lives. It is much more the consistent, faith-filled effort to stay in touch with Jesus, that we are transformed. Our opportunities of growing in holiness, sharing our faith, serving others, and being a good steward of all God's gifts are greatly improved if I give myself whole-heartedly to participating in the life of the Parish.

May God be Praised for the Graces of these last ninety years. May the Holy Spirit guide us, as we move forward together, to continue Christ's Mission by building on the great witness of those who have gone before us!

In the coming weeks and months there will be opportunities to celebrate as a Parish Family.




